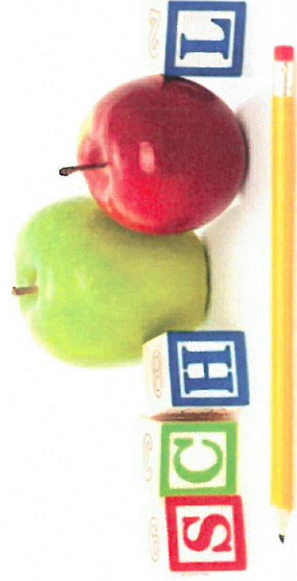


## The Mission of Georgetown's PreK- Entering Grade 2

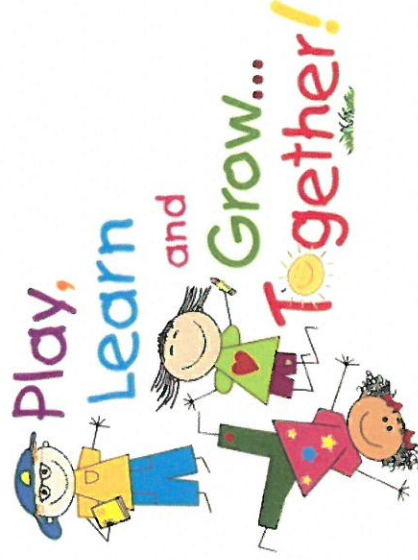

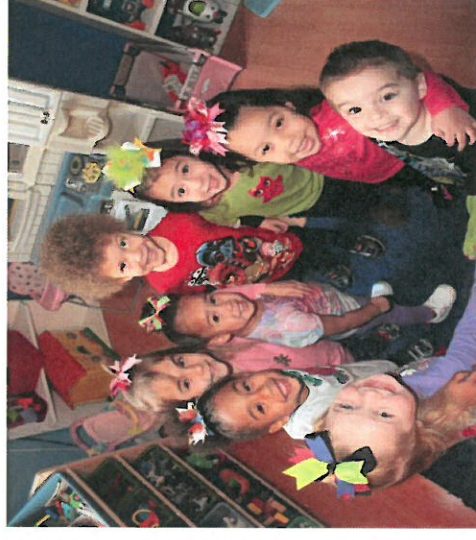
